Northern Kentucky Music Teachers' Association Performance Evaluations

The Northern Kentucky Music Teachers' Association (NKMTA) invites piano, strings and vocal students to participate in our spring performance evaluations. The event will be held on Saturday, May 12, 2018 at Northern Kentucky University. The time is TBA.

The entry fee is \$20.00 per student or \$35.00 per family for students of NKMTA members. An accompanist can be provided by NKMTA for a \$12 fee per student. Teachers who are non-NKMTA members must pay an additional \$20.00 studio fee.

Students_must perform two selections – **pianists' and vocalists' selections must be memorized**. **String participants need NOT memorize their music.** Selection of repertoire must adhere to the rules given to the teachers. All students will receive a ribbon the day of the evaluation. Students who receive superiors from both judges will receive a small trophy.

All students are offered the opportunity to take a theory test. The test will be offered in three different levels. It will be graded and returned via your private teacher. The score on the theory test will not affect the performance score in any way, however, many students enjoy seeing how well they can do.

The most important benefit of participating in any kind of performance evaluation is receiving feedback from someone other than the private teacher. In addition, the top 25% of participants in the NKMTA Festival will be invited to play in the fall Kentucky Music Teacher Association Honors Recital on Saturday, November 3, 2018 at the KMTA annual competitions weekend at Campbellsville University. We encourage those students of late intermediate to advanced levels to participate in the Bluegrass Competitions held the same weekend. You must indicate your wish to be considered for the Honors Recital in order to be considered.
